



Braid Hills Golf Course

Local Rules

The Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply and in addition the following Local Rules;

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest on or over any wall or fence bounding the course.

2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

- a) All roads, tracks and paths through the golf course.
- b) Staked trees
- c) All drainage covers
- d) All open stone filled drainage ditches

N.B. Any wall, fence, or other object defining the boundary of the course is not an obstruction. (A ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable, Rule 19).

3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR: PLAY PROHIBITED

Any part of the course as defined by an enclosed white line is ground under repair from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his/her intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief under Rule 16.1a.

4. SPRINKLER HEADS (Rule 16.1)

The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if a fixed sprinkler head is on the line of play, and is:

- a) within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
- b) within two club-lengths of the ball.

5. UNUSUAL GROUND CONDITIONS

Should the ball come to rest on the bridle path, or between the path and boundary fence/wall, a player may take a free drop, on the course side of the path, no nearer the hole. Subject to the normal boundary fence/wall being out of bounds of course.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

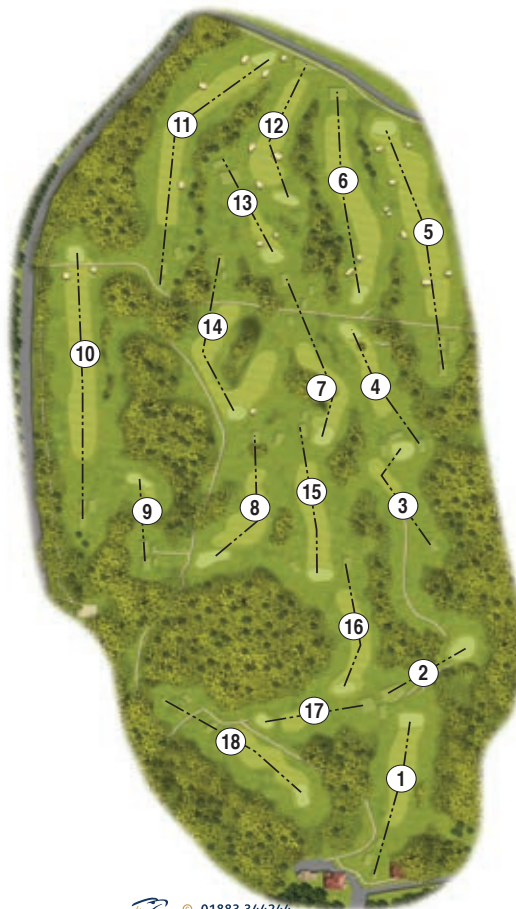
Match Play - Loss of Hole;
Stroke Play - Two Strokes.

ETIQUETTE

- a) Play at a good pace and keep up with the game in front.
- b) Repair any damage (spike or ball marks) made on the green, irrespective of who made them before leaving the green.
- c) Before leaving a bunker smooth over any holes or footprints.
- d) Repair/replace any divots.
