- Meadowbank Sports Centre is equipped with state-of-the-art plant room kit as it underwent refurb and opened in July 2022.
- The building is an energy efficient building. However, we don't have any renewable sources of energy installed at Meadowbank as of yet.

- It is equipped with two Combined Heat and Power units which are being commissioned now but these units use Natural gas as a fuel to produce Heat and Electricity.
